The high school (Grades 10-12) program of studies at WMLIS is inspected and certified by the Ministry of Education, British Columbia. This certification includes such items as:

- All courses taught in English
- Principal and all teachers are British Columbia certified
- Program meets instructional time requirements and provincial learning outcomes for all courses
- Sufficient courses are provided to enable students to graduate from grade 12
- All students must write all grade 10, 11 and 12 provincial examinations
- School must pass rigorous, annual, on-site inspections by British Columbia's Ministry of Education to ensure that all standards are met.
